Members must be participating directly in the developing world project for which they are seeking funding.

In general, in order to be considered for funding, projects must fall into the areas of financial and general education or cultural and community social programs.

The criteria underlying the current list of developing countries are:

- Low Income – based on a three-year average estimate of the gross national income per capita
- Weak Human Assets – based on skill sets/available education as measured through a composite Human Assets Index
- Economic Vulnerability - as measured through a composite Economic Vulnerability Index
